1. Through the instant petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. prayer is made for marking an enquiry to the learned Sessions Judge, Ferozepur, into the case of custodial death of the son of the present petitioner namely, Bharat Bhushan, who according to the petitioner died in a suspicious circumstance in the Central Jail, Ferozepur, on 03.03.2022.

2. On a pinpointed query put by this court, learned counsel for the petitioner fairly admits that the cause of death which evaluated by the board of doctors is pneumonia.

3. The submission made by learned counsel for the petitioner that the son of the petitioner has died because of the negligence on the part of doctors or on the part of the jail authority concerned, due to non-

providing of adequate treatment to his son, would be a disputed question of fact, and for that the petitioner may recourse to the alternative legal remedy as per law.

4. In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not want to press the instant petition.

5. **Dismissed as not pressed**, however, with liberty reserved to the petitioner to recourse with an alternative available statutory remedy(ies) before the appropriate authority/forum concerned, for redressal of his grievance.

6. All pending application(s), if any, stand **disposed** of accordingly.
