AMARJOT BHATTI, J. (Oral)

1. Status report filed by respondent-State is taken on record, subject to just exceptions.

2. Petitioners Martha and Harmanpreet Singh have filed petition under Article 226 of Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of Mandamus, directing respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect their life and liberty from the hands of respondents No. 4 to 8. Protection was provided as per order dated 24.05.2024 and status report was called. Thereafter, both petitioners appeared in Court on 13.08.2024 and jointly stated that they do not have any threat perception qua respondents No. 4 to 6 and 8. However, Chander Mohan alias Kala-respondent No. 7 was still interfering in their married life. In pursuance of this, supplementary status report was called for with the direction to record statement of respondent No. 7.

3. Today, alongwith status report, statement of respondent No. 7- Chander Mohan alias Kala is also placed on record who categorically stated that he will not interfere in married life of petitioners.

4. Respondent No. 7-Chander Mohan alias Kala is also present in Court and confirmed the facts stated in his statement recorded by police.

5. Today, nobody has turned up on behalf of petitioners, despite calling the case twice.

6. Considering the status report as well as statements of respondents as referred above, there is no threat perception. Therefore, present petition seeking protection has rendered infructuous and accordingly, disposed of.

In case, there is any threat perception to petitioners, they can always approach respondents No. 2 and 3, who will take appropriate action, considering threat perception.

7. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly.
