1. Notice of motion.
2. On asking of the Court, Ms. Mahima Yashpal, DAG, Haryana, appears and accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.
3. The substantial prayer made in the petition is as follows:

“It is therefore, respectfully prayed that the present petition may kindly be allowed and the direction may kindly be issued to the Learned Trial Court to expedite the proceedings in case bearing No. CHI-980-2021 titled State Vs Sunil arising out of FIR No. 0157 dated 04.08.2021 registered against the petitioner at PS: Women, Jhajjar and direct the Learned Trial Court to decide the same in some time-bound manner as almost 3 years have elapsed but the trial has not even moved an inch and even the complainant and her father have not come present as PW, therefore, the statement of no PW has been recorded till date;”
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has made reference to various zimni orders to argue that the trial is not proceeding & the petitioner is suffering on account of pendency of the FIR/trial against him.
5. In view of the totality of facts and circumstances of the case, the trial Court is directed to expedite the trial and conclude the same at



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earliest possible preferably within six months from date of receipt/production of certified copy of this order.
