1. Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of directions to respondent no.1 to provide an early and actual date of hearing in the appeal titled 'Gulshan Kumar Bagga VS Municipal Corporation, Faridabad & Others' Dated: 18.04.2024 (Annexure P-3) and also in stay Application dated 18.04.2024 filed along with the appeal. (Annexure P-4). Further prayer has been made to stay the 'demolition work' till the date of disposal of stay application by respondent no. 1.

2. It has been submitted that by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has already filed an appeal alongwith the stay application before the Divisional Commissioner, Faridabad i.e. respondent No.1 and the same is fixed for hearing on 03.07.2024. He submits that there is an apprehension of demolition of shop before the appeal is heard.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of this Court, Ms. Upasana Dhawan, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. She has submitted that the appeal alongwith the stay application filed

by the petitioner is fixed for hearing on 03.07.2024 before respondent No.1 and the stay application would be decided on the date fixed.

5. After hearing learned counsel for the parties, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 i.e. the Divisional Commissioner, Faridabad to decide the stay application filed alongwith the appeal by the petitioner on the date fixed before him i.e. on 03.07.2024 in accordance with law.

6. Till then status quo shall be maintained.
