1. By way of present petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, prayer has been made for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondent on account of alleged non-compliance of order dated 22.12.2023 passed by this Court in CWP-27824-2023. The operative part thereof is reproduced hereunder:-

“In the wake of statements of both sides, the petition stands disposed of with a direction to petitioner to appear before passport authority on 10.01.2024 along with requisite documents and explain his position with respect to passport No.A1362322. On doing so, the passport authority shall pass an appropriate order within six weeks from 10.01.2024.”

2. In response, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent submits that the passport already stands released in favour of the

petitioner in compliance of the aforesaid order dated 22.12.2023.

3. In such circumstances, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition, as such, the same is disposed of.

However, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival in case any cause survives. Rule stands discharged.
