The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.407 dated 24.11.2023 registered under Sections 148, 149, 285, 323, 336, 506 IPC and Sections 25/54/59 of Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Chhapar, District Yamuna Nagar.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 24.05.2024, the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

A status report dated 11.08.2024 by way of an affidavit of Kanwaljeet Singh, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Headquarter, Yamuna Nagar has been filed on behalf of the State by the learned counsel for the State. The same is taken on record. He counsel on instructions from ASI Jagdeep admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.
