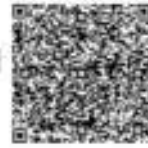

The prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.57 dated 14.04.2024 under Sections 323, 324, 506, 34 IPC and Section 326 IPC added later on registered at Police Station Bhawanigarh, District Sangrur.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 27.05.2024 **passed** by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel has filed Status report dated 03.08.2024 by way of affidavit of Mr. Gurdip Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Bhawanigarh, District Sangrur in the court today which is taken on record and on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 27.05.2024 and is



not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 27.05.2024 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
