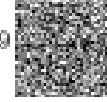

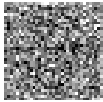

4. It is, *inter alia*, contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that despite the occurrence having taken place on 15.12.2022 and the FIR registered on the same day, the police has not made any effort to investigate the matter and even failed to locate the driver of the offending vehicle. He further contends that although the offending vehicle was recovered from the spot after having been left there by the offending driver thereof. He contends that the petitioner had moved a representation to the Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar, Punjab way back on 27.02.2024 (Annexure P-4) but till date no action has been taken thereon.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that for the purpose of the present petition, the petitioner will be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No. 3 to consider and dispose of the aforesaid representation in accordance with the law in an expeditious manner.

6. Learned State counsel has submitted that the aforesaid representation will be considered and disposed of in an expeditious manner according to law.

7. In view of the limited request made by learned counsel for the petitioner at this stage, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.3- Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar, Punjab, to consider the averments made in the representation dated 27.02.2024
