period of eight weeks from the receipt of any such claim and in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioner, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reason will be given for not accepting the claim of the petitioner in the speaking order to be passed.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty as prayed for.
