1. The prayer made in the present petition is for quashing the impugned order dated 27.10.2023 (Annexure P-8) passed by respondent no.3 qua the petitioner no.1 whereby the claim of the petitioners for grant of pending arrears of DA, ACP, CPF and pay anomaly was rejected.

2. Learned counsel would submit that the petitioners, who were working as ETT teachers, have not been granted benefit of pending arrears of DA, ACP, CPF and pay anomaly, despite the issue having been decided by this Court in **Ajmer Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and others**, CWP No. 27990 of 2022, decided on 6.12.2022. In this regard, a representation dated 08.11.2023, (Annexure P-5), has been submitted, which has yet not evoked any response. He thus, at this stage, on instructions, submits that the petitioners are sanguine of it being considered in a positive manner, in case, a direction is given to the respondents to decide the same in a time bound manner by granting him an opportunity of hearing.



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3. Notice of motion.
4. At the asking of the Court, Mr. Satnam Preet Singh, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and has no objection to the limited prayer made.
5. In view of the above and without commenting upon the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the representation dated 08.11.2023, (Annexure P-5), in light of the afore referred judgment, within a period of six months, which this Court has no reason to believe the authorities would not address in a just, fair and reasonable manner. Upon doing so, after notice and hearing offered to them and if found entitled, grant the benefit forthwith. Needless to say, if the orders are adverse to their interest, the same shall contain reasons and the petitioners shall be free to seek legal redress thereupon.
