In view of the agreed statements suffered by learned counsel for the appellant as well as learned counsel for the Insurance Company, both the parties have compromised for a total sum of Rs.60,000/- (Rupees Sixty thousand Only) over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal, to be paid to the appellant, as full and final settlement of the claim.

Accordingly, we dispose of the present appeal with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit cheque/draft in the sum of Rs.60,000/- (Rupees Sixty thousand) in favour of the appellant with the Office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within a period of four weeks from today. In case, the amount is not deposited within the prescribed period, the appellant shall be entitled to interest @ 9% per annum on the said amount from the date of this order till the date of realisation. The appellant's counsel may collect the cheque/draft from the office of the Lok Adalat. The office shall retain the photocopy of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the learned counsel for appellant as a receipt on record.

A copy of this order be supplied to learned counsel for the parties.
