1. Prayer in this writ petition is for directing respondents No.6 and 7 not to seize the vehicle of petitioner (Truck bearing RC No.PB05AJ8203) being means of livelihood of petitioner and to accept the request (Annexure P-9) submitted by petitioner to reduce the amount of installments.
2. Following order had been passed on 22.01.2024:-

“Though it is mentioned in order dated 12.10.2023 that in case there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner on the next date of hearing and arguments are not addressed, this writ petition shall stand dismissed in default and for non-prosecution, we are informed that lawyers have suspended work in view of Pran Pratishtha ceremony to be held in Shree Ram Mandir at Ayodhya today. There is a request that no adverse orders be passed for non appearance of counsel today.

In the interest of justice, adjourned to 18.04.2024.

In case there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner on the next date of hearing and arguments are not addressed for any reason whatsoever, this writ petition shall stand dismissed in default and for non-prosecution.

- 3. Today again there is no representation on behalf of petitioner. It appears that she is not interested in pursuing the matter any longer.
- 4. Writ petition is accordingly dismissed in default and for non-prosecution.
- 5. Pending miscellaneous applications, if any, stand disposed of accordingly.
