1. Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of direction to respondent no.2 and 3 to register the plot/shop no.41 located in Transport Nagar, Ludhiana which had been sold to the petitioner by an open bid by the respondents which would be evident from Annexure P-1 dated 18.11.1999 and P-2 dated 17.06.2002. Despite having cleared the dues and after having received the affirmative confirmation from the department, nothing has been done in the past 24 years. Further to issue direction to the respondents no.1 and 3 to expeditiously decide the representation of the petitioner dated 27.02.2024 Annexure P-9, in which the petitioner showcased his grievance in regard to the non-registration of his plot/shot, despite having furnished the entire consideration.

2. It has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that earlier the petitioner had approached this Court by way of filing CWP-25843-2023, which was disposed of by this Court vide order dated 17.11.2023. He submits that in pursuance to the same, respondent-MC has passed the order dated 15.01.2024 and the petitioner was intimated about

the same. He submits that the petitioner filed his representation (Annexure P-9) on receiving the same, but no action has been taken on the same.

3. Notice of motion.
4. On the asking of this Court, Mr. Ashok Bazaz, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of Municipal Corporation, Ludhiana (through VC).
5. After hearing learned counsel for the parties, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 i.e. the Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Ludhiana to decide the representation dated 27.02.2024 (Annexure P-9) in accordance with law, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of copy of this order order.
