The prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.PC is for issuance of directions to the concerned Jail Authorities to transfer Raghbir Singh from Jail Hospital, Patiala to the Civil Hospital, Patran in view of his current medical condition.

2. The Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was convicted and sentenced to undergo RI for 10 years in case FIR No.360 dated 02.9.2001 under Section 15 NDPS Act, P.S. Patran, District Patiala.

3. The petitioner was granted Parole which was extended from time to time. However, on 14.04.2023 the petitioner met with an accident and went into coma. The petitioner soon had approached the Jail Authorities regarding extension of the Parole, but the same had been declined. The petitioner was currently an inmate of the Jail Hospital at Patiala and in order



to that he be taken care of, he be transferred to the Civil Hospital at Patran close to the residence of his family.

4. The Counsel for the State has filed reply dated 22.07.2024 by way of affidavit of Mr. Manjit Singh Sidhu, Superintendent Central Jail, Patiala as well as Status report dated 26.08.2024 by way of affidavit of Mr. Inderpal Chohan, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Patran, District Patiala in the Court today, which are taken on record. While referring to the Status report dated 26.08.2024, he contends that the petitioner Raghbir Singh is in weak physical condition being bed ridden at his house and has 85% permanent physical impairment/mental disability. Therefore, appropriate orders be passed by this Court.

5. I have heard counsel for the parties.

6. Keeping in view the current physical condition of the petitioner- Raghbir Singh, he is directed to be transferred from the Jail Hospital, Patiala to Civil Hospital, Patran in custody. He be provided proper medical care in accordance with law.

7. The petition stands disposed of.
