1. Counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioner No.1 a female aged about 19 years is interested in getting married with petitioner No.2 a male aged about 20 years and presently both of them are living together against the wishes of respondents No.4 to 6 that the said private respondents are extending threats to cause harm to the petitioners in case they kept on living together and in this regard representation dated 22.05.2024 Annexure P-3 was submitted to respondent No.2 but the police authorities failed to take any action in this regard.

2. Notice of motion.

3. Mr. J.S. Dhaliwal, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of State of Punjab. He submits that the concerned authority will look into the matter and take decision on the representation of the petitioners in accordance with law.

4. In view of above, without going into the merits of the case, this

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petition is hereby disposed of with direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Fatehgarh Sahib to consider representation dated 22.05.2024 (Annexure P-3) and to take action if so warranted in accordance with law.

5. However, any observations made in this order will not be construed as an expression of opinion on the validity of the relationship of the petitioners. It is also made clear that respondents No.4 to 6 are at liberty to avail appropriate remedy available to them under law against the petitioners. In case the petitioners have committed any offence, law will take its own course.
