1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Sections 10 & 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 for initiating contempt proceedings against respondent for non-compliance of order dated 21.06.2023 passed in CRWP-6176-2023.
2. There is no provision in the Criminal Procedure Code for making representation as such, therefore, there is no scope for issuing any direction to the Police to consider and decide the representation *de hors* order for registration of the FIR and investigation of the case. However, there is no order for registration of the FIR and investigation of the case, as such.
3. Accordingly, even if the petitioner is entitled to some other remedy, this Court does not find this case fit for punishing the Police for contempt of Court, as such.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed.
5. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy before any other appropriate Court.
