The prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.21 dated 29.02.2024 under Sections 307 IPC registered at P.S. GRP Faridabad, District GRP Ambala.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 24.05.2024 **passed** by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel on instructions from ASI Satish Kumar submits that only simple injuries have been received by the complainant and the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 24.05.2024 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 24.05.2024 is



made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
