1. Petitioners have filed instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for directing respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect life and liberty of petitioners and not to interfere in personal life and liberty of petitioners which is in danger at the hands of respondent Nos.4 to 6 and other relatives and friends.

2. Therefore, at this stage, she wants to withdraw present petition with liberty to file fresh petition with better particulars.
