1. Though the instant petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.234 dated 24.04.2024 under Sections 408 and 420 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Old Industrial Area, Panipat, District Panipat.
2. Vide order dated 27.05.2024, passed by this Court, the petitioner was released on interim bail and was directed to join investigation.
3. Learned State counsel has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation on 05.06.2024 and he is not required for custodial interrogation. A copy of the order regarding depositing of the FDR of Rs.1 lakh has been placed on record.
4. Keeping in view the above facts and circumstances, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 27.05.2024, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
