1. Counsel for the petitioner submits that on 21.05.2024 when petitioner was all alone in her house, respondents No.5 to 10 trespassed into her house and gave her beatings and at that time some of the said respondents were also armed with country-made weapons. That with regard to the aforesaid incident petitioner lodged complaint dated 21.05.2024 (Annexure P-2) with respondent No.3 i.e. Superintendent of Police, Nuh on the same very day but the police authorities failed to take any action against the aforesaid respondents. Counsel for the petitioner further submits that petitioner will be satisfied if necessary direction is given to respondent No.3 i.e. Superintendent of Police, Nuh to look into



the matter and decide complaint dated 21.05.2024(Annexure P-2) submitted by the petitioner in accordance with law, in a time bound manner.

- 2. Notice of motion.
- 3. Mr. Neeraj Sheoran, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4 and submits that in case any such complaint (Annexure P-2) filed by the petitioner is pending, the same will be disposed of by the competent authority in accordance with law, in a given time frame.
- 4. In view of above and without going into the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.3 i.e. Superintendent of Police, Nuh to consider and decide representation dated 21.05.2024 (Annexure P-2) submitted by the petitioner in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
