In the present petition, grievance being raised by the petitioner is that though 45 posts of Dental Surgeon (Class-II), which were advertised vide advertisement No.02/2021 dated 25.02.2021 (Annexure P/1) by the respondents have not been filled up but still the claim of the petitioner, who is in waiting list, is not being considered by the respondents despite the fact that posts are still lying vacant hence, the petitioner is entitled to be considered for the appointment against the said vacant posts of Dental Surgeon (Class-II) keeping in view her merit.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that though, the petitioner has already raised the said grievance before the respondents by way of submitting a representation dated 15.03.2024 (Annexure P/9), which is still pending consideration with the respondents but liberty may kindly be



given to the petitioner to file additional representation also and the respondents be directed to decide the said representation in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that in case, representation dated 15.03.2024 (Annexure P/9) has been received from the petitioner and is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned and in case, any additional representation is also filed by the petitioner, the same will be decided in accordance with law and an appropriate speaking order will be passed within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of any such representation and in case, it is found feasible to grant the relief to the petitioner, the same will be extended to her otherwise, due reasons for not accepting the claim of the petitioner will be mentioned in the speaking order so passed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned counsel for the respondents, present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
