Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has not been given the pay scale as notified by the AICTE vide Notification dated 01.03.2019 (Annexure P/4).

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the said notification dated 01.03.2019 is based upon the Central Pay Commission, which is not being adhered too by the respondents so as to grant the petitioner benefit of actual pay scale for which the petitioner was entitled while working as Assistant professor with the respondent-University.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance before the respondent No.2-University by way of submitting a representation dated 08.05.2024 (Annexures P/10),

which is still pending consideration and the petitioner will be satisfied, at

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this stage, in case, a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representation.

Notice of motion.

Mr. T.P.S Chawla, Senior DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that in case, representation dated 08.05.2024 (Annexures P/10) has been received from the petitioner, the same will be decided by the respondent No.2/University in accordance with law and an appropriate speaking order will be passed within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order and in case, it is found feasible to grant the relief to the petitioner, the same will be extended to him otherwise, due reasons for not accepting the claim of the petitioner will be mentioned in the speaking order so passed, which will be conveyed to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement made by learned counsel for the respondents, present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
