HARKESH MANUJA J. (Oral)

1. By way of present petition, prayer has been made for initiation of contempt proceedings invoking Sections 10 & 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, alleging willful disobedience of order dated 08.02.2022 passed by this Court in CWP-5316-2021. The operative part thereof is extracted hereunder:-

“As an upshot, the impugned order dated 26.02.2021 (Annexure P-11) is set-aside. The instant petition is allowed with a direction to the respondents to re-induct the petitioner with continuity in job with all consequential benefits, including salary for the period she was rendered jobless for no fault of her. Arrears be paid along with interest at the rate of 7% per annum.

2. In response, compliance report by way of affidavit of Dr. Aditya Goyal, Deputy Civil Surgeon, Kaithal on behalf of respondent has been filed in Court today and the same is taken on record.
3. A perusal of aforesaid report shows that order dated 08.02.2022 passed by this Court in CWP-5316-2021, stands complied with by the respondent.
4. In view of the above, no cause survives in the present petition, as such, the same is disposed of.

Rule stands discharged.
