1. Prayer in the present petition is for seeking direction to the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioner for providing him his immigration records and travel history.

2. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner completed his Matriculation in the year 2015 and 10+2 in the year 2017 from the Board of School Education, Haryana. To pursue the medical career, the petitioner obtained admission in Jiujiang University, China, after due approval from the National Medical Council of India. The duration of the course was five years and the session commenced from the year 2017.

Passport No.P968846 was got prepared by the petitioner and he obtained Visa to China which was issued on 10.11.2017. It was originally issued till 10.02.2018 and thereafter was extended from time to time. The petitioner duly completed his course from the said University by attending the classes. Unfortunately, the petitioner lost his original passport and in this regard DDR dated 29.10.2020 was got registered in the Police Station Bus Stand Ballabhgarh, Faridabad. Thereafter, a new passport bearing No.U8396890, dated 01.02.2021 was issued to the petitioner. The petitioner successfully completed his course and all requisite certificates were issued by the University to him, whereupon the petitioner appeared for the FMGE exam conducted by the National Board of Examinations in Medical Science. The petitioner claims that he has cleared the said examination. However, he is required to submit the necessary documents as proof of his actual travel and on campus study in the Jiujiang University, China. Due to the passport of the petitioner having been lost, he is not in a situation to submit the original. He, accordingly, submitted an application/ representation to respondents No.3 and 4 to supply the information pursuant to the travel history of the petitioner as reflected in his earlier passport. However, the same is not being supplied to him.

3. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that in the event of the failure of the petitioner to submit the requisite documents, passing certificate of the examination conducted by the National Board of Examinations in Medical Science shall not be issued to the petitioner, compelling him to file the present petition.

learned counsel for respondents No.1 to 3 accepted notice and prayed for time to seek complete instructions and file response. The matter has remained pending for a period of two months but needful was not done.

5. I do not find any reason as to why the response has not been filed and as to why the information should not be furnished by the respondents especially when the petitioner is seeking his personal information and same was not related to any other. Taking into the urgency of the matter and the abovesaid circumstances, I intend to allow this petition.

6. Respondent No.4 is directed to furnish the travel details of the petitioner as against Passport No.P968846 within a period of one week from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

7. Petition is allowed accordingly.

8. Pending miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.

9. Let copy of this order be supplied to learned counsel for the respondents under the signatures of the Bench Secretary of this Court for making necessary compliance.
