Grievance of the petitioner is that FIR in question bearing No.144, under Sections 120-B, 406, 420, 467, 468, 471 IPC was registered at Police Station Sector 20, Panchkula, District Panchkula, way back on 18.11.2016, in which petitioner is an accused. Petitioner has moved an application for his discharge way back on 14.02.2022. Copy of that application is Annexure P-2.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has drawn attention towards the various zimni orders as passed by the Trial Court, adjourning the matter for one or the other reason and that application for discharge of the petitioner has not been decided so far.

3. Without issuing notice to the respondent-State, this petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the Trial Court concerned to decide the application dated 14.02.2022 (Annexure P-2) preferably within 02 months from the date of copy of receipt of this order. In case, the said application is not decided within 02 months, the Trial Court concerned shall inform the reasons thereof to this Court.
