MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner is seeking the concession of bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.663 dated 10.10.2018 under Sections 403, 406, 418, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 of the IPC registered at Police Station DLF-II, District Gurugram.

2. At the outset, learned State counsel, while opposing the prayer and submissions made by the counsel opposite, on instructions from ASI Bablish, has informed the Court that there has been non-compliance of the order dated 16.05.2023 and despite this Court having taken a lenient view and having adjourned the case time and again, the petitioner has failed surrender before the trial Court.

3. In the circumstances, as well as keeping in mind the instructions received by the learned State counsel, this Court does not

deem it fit to extend the concession of bail to the petitioner. The petition as such is dismissed. However, it is made clear that anything observed hereinabove shall not be construed to be an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
