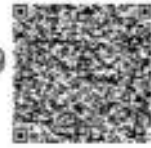

The prayer in the petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of Writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the officials respondents no.1 & 2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and also for the issuance of directions to the respondents to take legal action against the respondents no.5 and other unknown officials who tried to kidnap the petitioner for implicating him in false cases and who snatched the phone of the petitioner.

2. The Counsel for the petitioner contends that attempts were made to kidnap the petitioner and to implicate him in false cases. His mobile phone was also snatched by police officials. A representation had been moved on 23.03.2024 seeking appropriate action to be taken by the investigating agency against the respondents. As no action had been taken on the said representation, appropriate directions ought to be issued by this

Court in terms of the prayer made.



3. I have heard counsel for the petitioner.
4. A perusal of the record would reveal that on an earlier occasion a somewhat similar petition had been filed bearing CRWP-8687-2021 which came to be withdrawn vide order dated 06.02.2023 (Annexure P-2). The present petition has been filed with more or less similar prayers with the additional factual narration of an attempt to kidnap the petitioner and the snatching of his mobile phone. It appears that these allegations have been levelled to create a cause of action for the instant petition.
5. In view of the above, I find no merit in the present petition and the same stands dismissed. However, the petitioner is at liberty to avail his alternative remedies in accordance with law.
