The petition has been filed, *inter alia*, seeking a writ of certiorari quashing the action of respondents in not granting the benefit of an additional ten per cent of Basic Pay plus Dearness Allowance to the petitioner in terms of Teachers Transfer Policies, despite he being permitted to be posted in District Nuh (Mewat).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that grievance raised herein is pending for appropriate decision before respondent No.3. At this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied in case respondent No.3 is directed to decide his pending representation dated 15.03.2024, Annexure P-6, in a specified period.

3. Learned State counsel, appearing on advance notice, submits that the pending representation, dated 15.03.2024, will be decided by respondent No.3-Director General, Department of Secondary School



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Education, by passing a speaking order, in accordance with law, within three months.

4. In view of the statement made, learned counsel for the petitioner has no objection to the petition being disposed of in terms thereof.

5. Ordered accordingly.
