This is an application filed under Section 151 CPC for placing on record the copy of letter dated 14.06.2024 as Annexure P-5.

This is an application filed under Order 1 Rule 10 read with Section 151 of CPC for impleading Regional P.F. Commissioner, Regional Office, Jalandhar as respondent No.3 in the main petition.

In view of the averments mentioned in the application, the same is allowed. Regional P.F. Commissioner, Regional Office, Jalandhar is ordered to be impleaded as respondent No.3.

Amended memo of parties is taken on record.

Main case

1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ of mandamus directing the respondents grant and release revised pension and other pensionary benefits to

the petition by counting his work charge service period w.e.f 16.06.1987 to



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30.06.1999 along with already granted pension and pensionary benefits vide PPO No.129600/20-21 for his regular service for the period 01.07.1999 to 29.02.2020 along with interest @ 12% per annum.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the very outset, confines his prayer for deciding legal notice dated 20.02.2024 (Annexure P-4). He submits that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied, if the said legal notice is decided by passing a speaking order within a time bound frame.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Ms. Armaan Saggar, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and has no objection to the innocuous prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the record of the case.

6. Without going into the merits of the case at this stage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1, to decide legal notice dated 20.02.2024 (Annexure P-4), submitted by the petitioner expeditiously by passing a speaking order, preferably within a period of 04 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
