1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 & 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondent for disobeying the order dated 07.03.2024 passed in CRM-M-11930-2024.
2. Notice of motion.
3. Mr. Gunjan Mehta, Addl. Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent and has produced copy of speaking order dated 24.05.2024, vide which, claim of the petitioner and has been rejected. Copy of said speaking order is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan the same and place it at appropriate place. Copy thereof has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute the same.
5. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
6. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-redressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
