AWARD OF LOK ADALAT BENCH NO.5

The present appeal has been filed under Section 166 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (hereinafter called as 'the Act').

Learned counsel for the appellants has circulated power of attorney today which is taken on record.

The appeal stands settled at Rs.6,10,000/- over and above the amount already awarded by the learned Tribunal in terms of proposal form dated 12.08.2024 duly signed by both the parties.

Accordingly, this award is made with the direction to the Insurance Company to deposit the enhanced amount of Rs.6,10,000/- (Rupees Six Lacs and Ten Thousand Only) by cheque/draft, in favour of appellant No.1-Rani with the Office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 30.09.2024. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellants' counsel may collect the cheque/draft from the office of the Lok Adalat. The office shall retain the photocopies of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the Counsel.

The particulars of the policy in issue have not been mentioned and are not on record.

The District Judge, Ambala is directed to fax the photocopy of the Insurance policy Exhibit R-E in MACT Case No.127 of 2005 decided on 16.10.2006 by Sh. Ram Chand Gupta, Motor Accietns Claims Tribunal, Ambala within a week from today.

Appeal stands disposed of in terms of the settlement.
