The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.PC with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.134 dated 22.07.2023 under Sections 323,341,506,324,325,326,148,149,201 of IPC, registered at Police Station Salem Tabri, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 29.05.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Jagjiwan also submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.
