1. The present writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of an appropriate order or direction calling for the record of the case and after perusal of the same issue a writ in the nature of *certiorari* for quashing the impugned action of the respondent-Commission for not considering the candidature of the petitioner under DESM-General Category for the post of ALM against the advertisement No.11/2019 dated 05.07.2019, Category No.21 (Annexure P-1) with a further prayer in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondent-Commission to consider the petitioner under DESM-General category in the Revised Final Selection List dated 06.07.2022 (Annexure P-16) for the post



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of Assistant Lineman against the advertisement No.11/2019 dated 05.07.2019, Category No.21 (Annexure P-1) and select the petitioner under the aforesaid category by placing him at an appropriate place in the selection list/final revised result vide Annexure P-16.

2. Both the learned counsels for the petitioner and the private respondent as well as the learned State Counsel are *ad idem* that the present case is squarely covered by the judgment passed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court in **CWP-11694-2022** titled as “**Sandeep Vs. State of Haryana and another**” decided on 10.10.2022, which has been upheld in LPA-977-2023 and the present petition can also be disposed of in the same terms.

3. In view of the statement made by all the learned counsels for the parties, the present petition is disposed of in the same terms as that of the aforesaid writ petition i.e. CWP-11694-2022.
