Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that against the fixing of the seniority in the cadre of Clerks, which is causing prejudice to the petitioners , the petitioners have already submitted a legal notice dated 21.03.2024 (Annexure P-15) which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioners will be satisfied at this stage in case, a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

3. Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.
4. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case, the legal notice dated 21.03.2024 (Annexure P-15) has been received in the office of concerned authorities and is still pending consideration, the same will be decided by the authorities concerned within a period of eight weeks of the

receipt of copy of this order and in case, after the decision of the representation, any benefit accrues to the petitioner, the same will also be released to them otherwise due reasons will be mentioned in the speaking order for not accepting the claim of the petitioners for their information and necessary action.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
