1. This is a contempt petition filed under Article 215 of the Constitution of India, read with Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 01.03.2024 passed in CRWP-1979-2024.

2. Notice of motion.

3. Mr. Gunjan Mehta, Addl. A. G. Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent.

4. Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 01.03.2024 passed in CRWP-1979-2024 has since been complied with and threat perception to the life of the petitioner has been considered and appropriate decision has been taken by passing a speaking order. Copy of the aforesaid speaking order, produced by the counsel for the respondent in the Court today, is taken on record.

5. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.

6. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-
redressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate
remedy, but in accordance with law.
