1. Counsel for the petitioner submits that respondents No.4 to 6 committed fraud against the present petitioner and lured her to hand over Rs.42 lacs to them but thereafter respondents No.4 to 6 failed to fulfil their promise and refused to return the amount and also retracted from compromise which was later on effected between the parties. It is further submitted that in this regard petitioner has already given complaint/representation dated 14.05.2024 (Annexure P-1) to respondent No.2 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Mohali but the police authorities failed to take any action in this regard. Counsel for the petitioner further submits that petitioner will be satisfied if necessary direction is given to respondent No.2 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Mohali to look into the matter and to consider and decide complaint/representation dated 14.05.2024 (Annexure P-1) submitted by



the petitioner in accordance with law, in a time bound manner.

2. Notice of motion.
3. Mr. Jasjeet Singh Dhaliwal, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 and submits that in case any such complaint/representation (Annexure P-1) submitted by the petitioner is pending, the same will be disposed of by the competent authority in accordance with law, in a given time frame.
4. In view of above and without going into the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Mohali to consider and decide complaint/representation dated 14.05.2024 (Annexure P-1) submitted by the petitioner in accordance with law within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
