1. Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to apprise this Court with a status report in regard to the whereabouts of accused and the measures adopted by police to arrest accused Navpreet Singh, whose anticipatory bail dated 29.07.2017 (Annexure P-2) was dismissed by this Court and he was declared proclaimed offender by learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class in case bearing FIR No.121 dated 03.05.2015 registered under Sections 376/109/420 of IPC at Police Station Patti.

2. In compliance of order passed by this Court on 27.08.2024, learned State counsel has filed the affidavit of even date of Abhimanyu Rana, IPS, Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3, which is taken on record. He submits that the grievance raised by the petitioner, in the present petition has been substantially redressed and accused has been arrested and final report qua him has also been presented before the jurisdictional/Illaq Magistrate. As such, nothing survives in the

present petition and the same has become infructuous.

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3. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition.
4. Dismissed as withdrawn as having been rendered as infructuous.
