1. Prayer in this revision petition is for setting aside the impugned order dated 13.05.2024 (Annexure P-5), passed by the Additional District Judge, Bhiwani, vide which the appeal of the respondents was allowed by the Appellate Court by setting aside the order of the learned trial Court dated 03.03.2022 (Annexure P-4) and the matter was remanded back to the learned trial Court to pass afresh order.
2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner restricts his prayer to issue directions to the learned Trial Court to decide the matter expeditiously.
3. Given the limited prayer, the issuance of notice to the respondents is dispensed with.
4. I have heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and with his able assistance, have gone through the paper-book.



5. In view of the above and limited prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, learned Trial Court is directed to dispose of the application under Order 39 Rules 1 and 2 CPC, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

6. It is to be noted that concept of right to speedy trial focuses on expeditious case resolution to enhance the efficacy and credibility of judiciary.

7. Needless to mention, parties to the case shall assist the Court in expeditious disposal of the case.

8. In view of the above, this revision petition stands disposed of accordingly.

9. Pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of accordingly.
