JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J (ORAL)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of impugned judgment dated 15.03.2024 (Annexure P-8) whereby reinstatement of Private respondent Nos. 1 and 2 in service with full backwages has been allowed.
2. Mr. Sandeep Bansal, Advocate submits that as per his instructions, the petitioner-college is ready to pay a sum of Rs. 5,00,000/- to each of the respondents. The said amount would be paid within 3 weeks from today.
3. Mr. Keshav Gupta, Advocate agrees to the aforesaid arrangement.
4. In the wake of statement of both sides, the present petition stands disposed of.



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5. The respondents would be at liberty to move an appropriate application, if the said amount is not paid within 3 weeks from today. The said amount would be full and final and respondents would not make any claim against the petitioner in future. The petitioner-college at the time of making this payment would issue experience certificate to the respondents.
6. Disposed of in above terms.
7. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
