1. By way of present petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, prayer has been made for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondents on account of alleged willful non-compliance of order dated 14.02.2024 passed by this Court in CWP-13481-2021.

2. In response, learned counsel representing the respondents has produced a copy of order dated 12.09.2024, which reflects that compliance of aforementioned order dated 14.02.2024, has been made and on instructions submits that the entire payment due towards the petitioner shall be released in her favour within a period of two weeks' from today.

3. In view of the aforesaid undertaking, learned counsel for the petitioner does not want to press the present petition.

4. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed being not pressed.
5. Rule stands discharged.

 However, in case the needful is not done within the
aforementioned period, as per the undertaking, the petitioner would be at
liberty to seek revival of contempt petition and in that eventuality, the
erring/concerned officer would be liable to pay a sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs
from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation
expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
