The instant writ petition is disposed of with a mandamus, upon, the Appellate Authority concerned, seized with statutory Appeal No.247 of 2024(Annexure P-2), and, also seized with the application for staying the operation of the impugned order dated 03.08.2023(Annexure P-3), to within a period of three (03) months from today, thus, make a lawful speaking decision, upon, the said impugned annexures, but only after hearing all affected persons concerned.

The Appellate Authority concerned, is directed to, within a period of two weeks from today, make a lawful speaking decision upon the application concerned, whereby, the applicant/appellant has asked for staying the operation of the verdict passed by the learned Collector concerned, but till the making of the said order, the parties are directed to maintain, *status quo*, as of today, in respect of the disputed sites.
