1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for violating the order dated 09.04.2024 passed in CWP-29669-2022.

2. Notice of motion.

3. Mr. Gunjan Mehta, Addl. Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and has submitted that the possession of the house in question has already been handed over to the petitioner. Therefore, the order passed by the Writ Court stands complied with and if there is any disturbance to the life of the petitioner, then she may be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy available with her under the Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Act, 2007.

4. The factum regarding handing over the possession of the house in question to the petitioner has not even been disputed by learned counsel for the petitioner.

5. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.

6. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, if any grievance arises even after taking the possession of the house in question.
