ARUN PALLI, J. (Oral)

With reference to the order dated 01.03.2024 (P-13), passed by this Court in an earlier petition filed by the petitioners **(CWP-4928-2024)**, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, submits that apparently, the petition at hand is not even maintainable. But, be that as it may, he submits that the Director, Town and Country Planning, Haryana, has already taken cognizance of the matter. And the petitioners, as also the other stakeholders, would be heard on 10.06.2024 as regards their concerns/grievances. Thus, it is urged that nothing substantive survives in this petition and the same be disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous.

That being so, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that let the petition be disposed of, in terms of the statement made by learned State counsel.

In the wake of the above and in terms of the statements made by learned counsel for the parties, the petition is, accordingly, disposed of.

However, in the event, the matter does not make any tangible progress on 10.06.2024 and no effective measures/steps are taken, the petitioners shall be at liberty to move a necessary application in this petition itself for restoration and appropriate orders.
