This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for disobedience of the judgment dated passed by Hon'ble the Supreme Court in *Arnesh Kumar Vs. State of Bihar, 2014 (8) SCC 273*, reiterated in *Md Asfak Aslam Vs. State of Jharkhand and another, 2023 Livelaw (SC) 583*.

2. The facts and circumstances involved in the case are of such nature that for assessing the non-compliance of the order, if any, would require determination of a lot of disputed question of facts. However, adjudicating upon the disputed question of facts would not be appropriate in the contempt petition. Hence, the present petition deserves to be dismissed.

3. Dismissed.

4. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail any alternate remedy, if he perceives any grievance, in this matter qua any authority.
