NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of certiorari, quashing the order dated 15.01.2021 (Annexure P-7), whereby respondent No.1-Appellate Authority has set aside the reasoned order dated 13.07.2020 passed by the Disciplinary Authority and charge-sheet dated 29.01.2016 (Annexure P-3) issued by the Appellate Authority usurping the power of the Punishing Authority.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the averments made in the additional affidavit dated 20.07.2023 filed by Mr. Manjit Singh, Under Secretary, Government of Punjab, Department of Local Government, on behalf of respondents No.1 & 2, nothing survives in the present petition except the claim with regard to the



arrears on account of grant of retrospective promotion. He further submits that liberty may be granted to the petitioner to make representation for claiming arrears on account of grant of retrospective promotion.

3. Disposed of as having become infructuous with liberty as aforesaid.
