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**MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J. (ORAL)**

1. The petitioner is seeking the concession of anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.69 dated 12.04.2024 under Sections 306 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Mahilpur, District Hoshiarpur.

2. On 28.05.2024, while noticing the following submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, a Coordinate Bench of this Court, had granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioner and asked him to join investigation:-

*“Learned counsel for the petitioner, inter-alia, submits that the petitioner happens to be the brother-in-law of wife of deceased and has nothing to do with the case.”*

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of order dated 28.05.2024, the petitioner has joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency.

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4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Raman Kumar, does not dispute the factum of the petitioner having joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency. He, on further instructions, has submitted that during investigation the petitioner had been found innocent and he is not required for further investigation much less for his custodial interrogation.

5. In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 28.05.2024, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
