1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 18.01.1995 passed in CWP-18430-1991.

3. Mr. Pawan Kumar Longia, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.
4. Counsel for the respondents submits that the present petition is totally frivolous, as has been filed without there being any basis. There is no question of the petitioners being entitled to any pay scale retrospectively, in terms of the order/judgment dated 18.01.1995, rendered by this Court in CWP-11738-1988.
