1. The petitioner through the instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to grant compassionate appointment.

2. The petitioner on the earlier occasion, preferred CWP-16704-2023 which was withdrawn vide order dated 22.09.2023. The order dated 22.09.2023 is reproduced as below:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the outset, seeks permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to approach authorities for the redressal of his grievance.

Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.

The respondent-bank may consider case of the petitioner sympathetically, however, in accordance with law.”
