1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for disobedience of the order dated 27.01.2023 passed in CWP-1616-2023.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents has submitted that the order dated 27.01.2023 passed in CWP-1616-2023 has been complied with and necessary payments have already been paid to the petitioner. Documents to this effect have also been annexed with the compliance report.
