HARSH BUNGER J. (ORAL)

1. Petitioner (Sudha Gautam) has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking direction upon the respondents to finalize the Voluntary Retirement Scheme (V.R.S.) applied by her, which has already been sanctioned by the competent authority, and in pursuance to it, further directing the respondents to release the General Provident Fund (G.P.F.), gratuity, voluntary retirement pension, commutation pension, leave encashment and other benefits consequential to retirement, in a time bound manner.

2. A perusal of file reveals that on the last date of hearing (16.08.2023), there was no representation on behalf of the petitioner and

Registry was directed to notify learned counsel for the petitioner of the next date fixed (05.12.2023), i.e. today.
